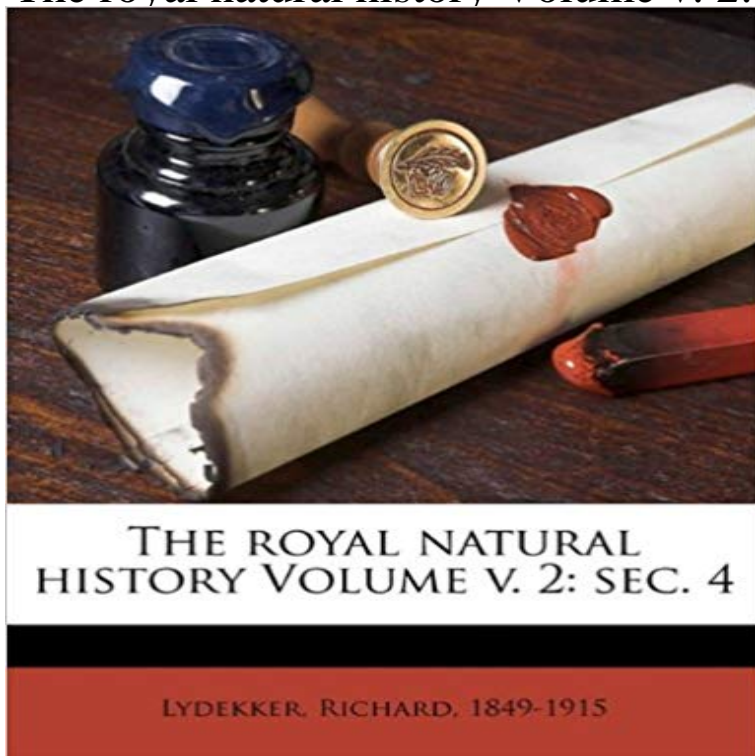


The royal natural history Volume v. 2: sec. 4
