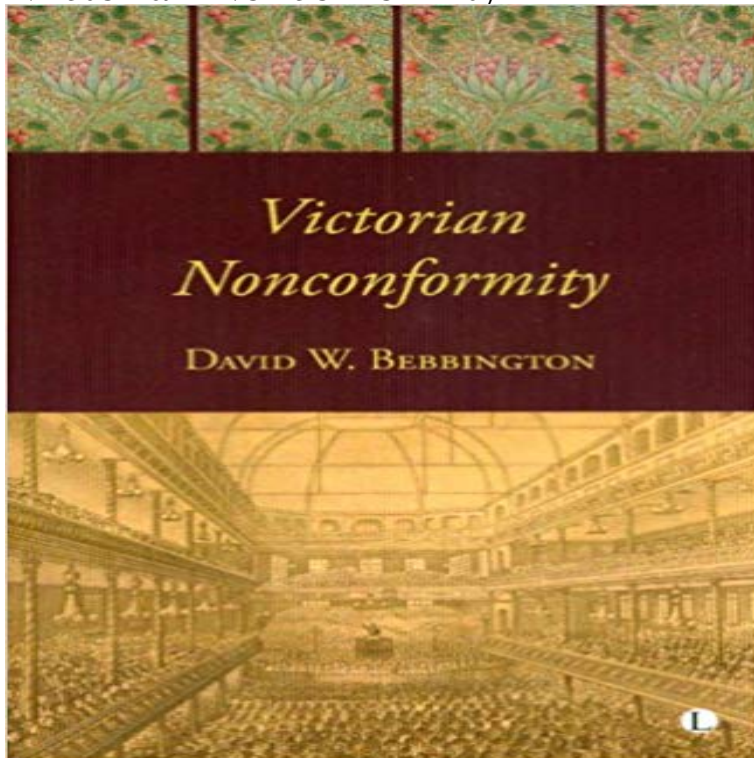


Victorian Nonconformity
