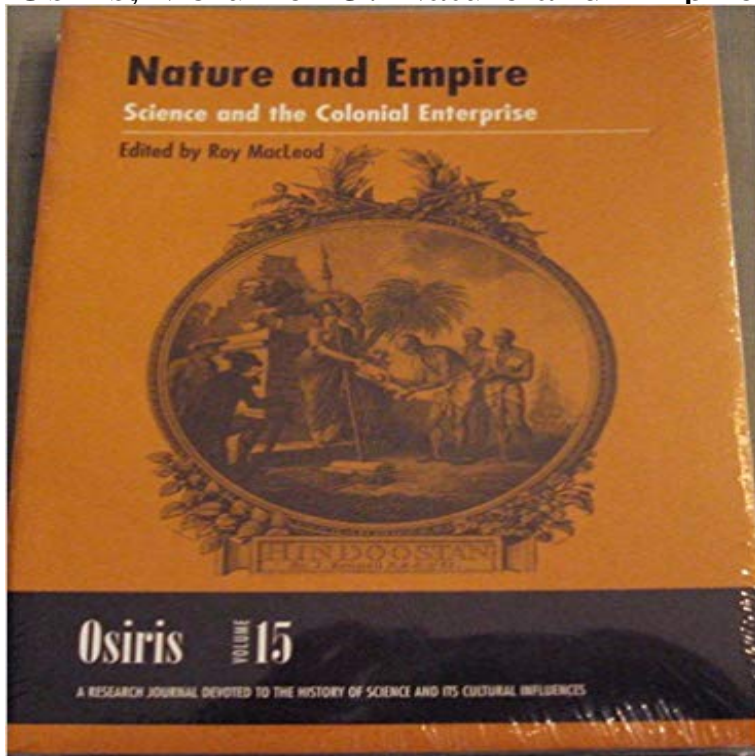


Osiris, Volume 15: Nature and Empire
